

Dynamics of Membrane Systems

The first Conference of CRC 1208 will provide an open forum for presenting and discussing the latest research on membrane biology. “Dynamics of Membrane Systems“ will focus on four themes representing the mission of our Research Center. Attendees are invited to stretch their boundaries, form collaborations, attend sessions outside their own areas of expertise, and learn how to apply exciting new tools and techniques to their own research. Early career researchers will also find a forum to exchange knowledge, approaches, and information regarding emerging techniques.

Focus of the Collaborative Research Center 1208 is the elucidation of “Identity and Dynamics of Membrane Systems - from Molecules to Cellular Functions”.

Twenty groups from the Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences and the Medical Faculty started their projects in January 2016 at the Heinrich-Heine-University in Düsseldorf, Germany, funded by the German Research Foundation (DFG).

More than 40 doctoral and postdoctoral researchers join the integrated graduate school “MB Train” to learn about the interdisciplinary field of biochemistry, cell biology and biophysics centered around membrane biology.
